

Chiles v Bolles

The Chiles Timberwolves pulled out a 2 – 1 victory over Jacksonville’s Bolles Bulldogs on a cold Friday evening as part of the Capital City Classic. Kickoff was 5:35 p.m. Field conditions were muddy and slippery from recent rain.

The starting lineup for Chiles was as follows:

Evan Cameron –keeper
#4 Justin Dillenscheider
#5 Daniel Campbell
#7 Kent Deckerhoff
#10 Alex Schroepfer
#11 Jake Parker
#12 Nathan Eppinger
#14 Chris Kessling
#15 Nicolai Modrow
#16 Cole Hoffman

The match commences as the Bulldogs kick off and feed the ball back to their side of the field. They then attempt to switch to the near sideline, but Chiles steals control of the ball and Bolles has to clear out. Jake Parker throws in as a feed to Daniel Campbell in the center, but Bolles clears the ball out to midfield, takes control, and tries to drive from midfield.

Chiles quickly stops this advance at midfield and drives back to Bolles’ side. However, Bolles clears back to midfield and drives down the far sideline to Chiles’ side. Chiles clears the ball out. Bolles attempts a shot immediately after the throw-in, but Evan Cameron grabs the ball for the stop in the 3rd minute.

After Evan clears, the Timberwolves advance to Bulldogs’ territory. Chiles loses the ball out. On the Bulldog throw-in, Daniel Campbell picks the ball and feeds to Nicolai Modrow who sends it on to Cole Hoffman who drives to Bolles’ goal but the Bulldogs clear out in the 4th minute.

After further play, Chiles clears the ball out in their territory. Bolles throws in and switches the field setting up a shot in the 7th minute that Evan Cameron stops with a grab. A Chiles counter-drive starts with Cole Hoffman taking off from midfield and passing to Kent Deckerhoff who feeds to Daniel Campbell. Daniel takes the ball down to Bolles’ corner and the Bulldogs clear out the endline. On the ensuing Chiles corner kick, Chris Kessling takes a shot as a header but misses over the top of the goal in the 10th minute.

The Bulldogs drive back down to the Timberwolves' box on the clear, but Evan Cameron runs out of the goal and makes the grab for the stop. Evan clears to midfield and the ball goes back and forth with neither team in clear control. Chiles eventually wins control, and Cole Hoffman shoots in the 14th minute, but Bolles' keeper stops. Bolles then tries to work back to Chiles' side, but loses the ball out. Jake Parker throws in a high ball to Kent Deckerhoff who passes to Cole Hoffman who pulls a quick spin-around and shoots in the 15th minute, but again Bolles' keeper makes the stop. On the Bolles clear, Chiles regains control and Chris Kessler heads the ball to Nicolai Modrow who shoots a GOAL from the top of 18 in the 15th minute!

Chiles 1 – Bolles 0.

Bolles kicks off, but Chiles steals the ball and tries to drive. The attempt is stopped by the Bulldogs defenders and the ball goes back to midfield with neither team in clear control. Bolles then breaks the stalemate, drives and shoots in the 20th minute but Samuel Weeks and Justin Dillenschneider block the shot out the endline. Bolles sends the corner in as a high floating ball, but Chris Kessler heads the ball out. Play stops on the first period water break.

When play resumes, Chiles is called for a penalty in Bolles territory. Bolles sends the free kick to midfield where Chiles is called for another penalty. Bolles kicks another free kick as a high ball that drops right in front of Chiles' goal where Bolles' Drew Gibson knocks in the ball for a goal in the 25th minute.

Chiles 1 – Bolles 1.

Chiles kicks off to resume play. During a Chiles drive, Jake Parker crosses to Kent Deckerhoff who shoots but misses over the goal top in the 27th minute. Colby Sowerby subs in for Jake Parker. Matt Salib subs in for Daniel Campbell. After further play, Chiles picks off a Bolles drive at midfield, and Matt Salib passes to Kent Deckerhoff who sends the ball on to Nicolai Modrow, but the Bolles defenders clear the ball back. This clear allows Samuel Weeks to shoot in the 31st minute, but Bolles' keeper makes the stop.

Bryant McBride subs in for Samuel Weeks. Another Chiles drive starts when Chris Kessler picks the ball near midfield, advances up, and passes to Kent Deckerhoff. Kent crosses the ball in to Nicolai Modrow who shoots in the 35th minute but misses the goal wide left. After the Bolles goal kick, Derek Reed drives down to Bolles' corner and crosses to Nicolai Modrow who shoots in the 36th minute, but Bolles' keeper makes the stop.

Luke Olsen comes in for Nicolai Modrow. Another Chiles shot is set up by Matt Salib who drives up in front of Bolles' box and passes to Chris Kessler who takes the ball wide and shoots in the 38th minute, but Bolles' keeper makes the stop. Bolles clears the ball short and passes around among their defenders. Luke Olsen applies pressure forcing Bolles to clear out. Chiles throws in from the far sideline and Matt Salib takes a shot in stoppage that Bolles' keeper stops.

HALFTIME

Bolles 1 – Chiles 1.

Chiles kicks off the second period. Bryant McBride comes in the game and takes a shot in the 44th minute that is stopped by Bolles' keeper. In another Chiles drive, Luke Olsen passes to Colby Sowerby who sends back to Bryant McBride, but Chiles is called for a penalty at midfield. Bolles sends the free kick as a goal shot but misses over the top in the 48th minute. Justin Dillenschneider sends the resulting goal kick to midfield, but Bolles picks the ball, drives down and shoots which is stopped by Evan Cameron's grab in the 49th minute.

Nicolai Modrow substitutes in for Cole Hoffman. Bryant McBride subs in for Matt Salib. The Timberwolves go back on offense when Kent Deckerhoff nabs the ball near midfield, drives down to the Bulldogs' goal and shoots in 52nd minute but misses just right. After further play, Luke Olsen starts a fast break at midfield, drives up the near sideline to the Bulldogs' corner, and passes back to Nicolai Modrow who then crosses the ball to the far side where Kent Deckerhoff shoots in the 53rd minute but misses over the goal top. Luke Olsen then gets his own shot out of a crowd of Bulldog defenders that misses over the top of the Bulldogs' goal in the 54th minute.

Daniel Campbell, Conor Munro, and Jake Parker sub in, and Luke Olsen, Kent Deckerhoff, and Chris Kessler go out. When play resumes, Bolles is penalized in their left corner. Justin Dillenschneider sends the free kick as a high ball to the left side of Bolles' goal box and Alex Schroepfer tries to head the ball in but Bolles' keeper stops. Samuel Weeks comes in for Cole Hoffman. Kent Deckerhoff subs in for Nathan Eppinger.

After further play, on a Chiles throw-in Daniel Campbell grabs the ball and shoots the 66th minute but misses over the goal top. Timberwolves defense and offence team up when Justin Dillenschneider makes big head stop at midfield that sends the ball to Daniel Campbell who tries to set up a shot, but has to feed to Chris Kessler who takes a shot in the 70th minute but misses over the top of the goal. The Timberwolves' efforts finally produce benefits when Chris Kessler passes to Conor Munro who sends the ball through to Daniel Campbell who shoots a GOAL in the 71st minute!

Chiles 2 – Bolles 1.

As the match concludes, Chiles gets off many shooting attempts but no further goals. Colby Sowerby feeds in to Conor Munro who heads in a shot in the 76th minute, but Bolles' keeper makes the grab. After further play, Daniel Campbell, passes to Derek Reed who feeds to Conor Munro who shoots in the 77th minute but misses just wide right.
