

**Godby v. Chiles**

The Chiles Timberwolves produced a commanding 6-0 victory over the Godby Cougars in a Timberwolf shooting fest on a cool windy Thursday evening. The Timberwolves entered the game with a record of 6-6-1. Kickoff was at 7:05 p.m.

The Chiles starting lineup was announced as follows:

Porter Watson - keeper

Jake Parker and Evan Cameron represented Chiles at the captains' meeting.

Godby kicked off the match. Chiles quickly won control of the ball at midfield. Chiles' shooting spree began when Conor Munro drives up from midfield, passes to Cole Hoffman, who switches out to Ali Farsi, who drives down in front of Godby's box. Godby fouls and Bryant McBride free kicks a pass to Conor Munro who shoots in the 5<sup>th</sup> minute but misses wide right.

Godby's keeper kicks a short goal kick that Conor Munro intercepts and passes to Cole Hoffman who breaks free of the Godby defenders and shoots but misses wide left in the 6<sup>th</sup> minute. Godby takes the goal kick and drives to the Chiles side. The Chiles defenders send the ball back to Porter Watson who switches to the ball to Bryant McBride who passes to Dylan Farrell who passes to Joey Antworth who crosses to Matt Salib. The cross allows Matt to take a shot that is blocked by the Godby defense in the 7<sup>th</sup> minute.

After further play, the ball goes out on Chiles. The officials stop play because the corner flag on the Chiles side keeps falling down due to the high winds. When play resumes, Godby throws in and makes an errant kick that allows Evan Cameron to steal the ball and shoot a GOAL in 10<sup>th</sup> minute!

Chiles 1 – Godby 0.

Godby kicks off and makes several drives towards Chiles' side. But these drives end without a shot attempt as Godby either sends the ball too far allowing Porter Watson to

grab or loses the ball out the endline resulting in a Porter Watson goal kick. Chiles ends Godby's advance by stealing the ball and advancing to Godby's side, causing Godby to clear out. Joey Antworth throws in to Luke Olsen who crosses out to Matt Salib who shoots in the 16<sup>th</sup> minute, but Godby's keeper stops.

Further play results in a Chiles midfield foul that allows Godby to launch a free kick at Chiles' goal that sails over Chiles' defenders but is stopped by Porter Watson. Porter clears the ball to Conor Munro who passes to Joey Antworth who drives down the Godby side, but Godby clears out. Joey throws in as a cross to Matt Salib who shoots in the 19<sup>th</sup> minute but Godby deflects the ball over the goal top. The Chiles corner is stolen by Godby who drives to the Chiles side, but Ali Farsi clears out. Godby then sends a low throw-in from the far sideline that allows a Godby shot which is stopped by Porter Watson's grab in the 20<sup>th</sup> minute.

After the first period water break, Chiles drives to Godby's side and Godby clears out. Jake Autry throws in to Dylan Farrell who passes to Bryan McBride who shoots but misses left in the 23<sup>rd</sup> minute. Godby's keeper kicks a high but short goal kick that Conor Munro picks and passes to Bryant McBride who passes to Matt Salib. Matt passes back to Joey Antworth who crosses to Conor Munro who shoots but misses over the goal top in the 24<sup>th</sup> minute.

Justin Dillenschneider subs in for Quinton Williams. Chiles drives to Godby's side and works the ball among Dylan Farrell, Evan Cameron, Bryant McBride and Matt Salib trying to set up a shot. Godby clears the ball out. Ali Farsi throws in to Dylan Farrell who shoots the ball straight in from just beyond the box in the middle of the field for a GOAL in the 26<sup>th</sup> minute!

Chiles 2 – Godby 0.

After the Godby kick off, Chiles drives to Godby's side and Conor Munro passes to Cole Hoffman who passes to Luke Olsen who shoots but misses just left in the 28<sup>th</sup> minute. After Godby clears, Conor Munro shoots in the 29<sup>th</sup> minute which Godby's keeper stops. Another Godby clear allows Chiles to drive inside Godby's box where Joey Antworth is fouled. Ali Farsi takes the penalty kick which Godby's keeper blocks back slightly. Ali uses this partial deflection to take another shot in the 30<sup>th</sup> minute that Godby's keeper also stops. Another Godby foul allows Conor Munro to send a free kick at Godby's goal which misses over the top in the 34<sup>th</sup> minute.

After further play, Godby drives deep into Chiles' territory on the far sideline where Chiles deflects the ball out the endline. On the resulting Godby corner, Joey Antworth makes a big clear which Chiles loses out. Joey then steals the Godby throw-in and tries to drive but Godby clears out. Jake Autry then throws in to Joey who feeds to Luke Olsen, but Godby clears out the endline. Luke Olsen sends the resulting corner up in front of Godby's goal, but the Godby defense clears out with a head.

HALFTIME: Chiles 2 – Godby 0.

Chiles substitutes extensively for the second period sending in Daniel Campbell, Kent Deckerhoff, Chris Kessler, Nicolai Modrow, Jake Parker, Cole Hoffman, Alex Schroepfer, Samuel Weeks, Nathan Eppinger, Justin Dillenschneider and Taylor Kostrzewa as keeper. Chiles kicks off and begins a big drive, but is called offside. After the free kick, Godby loses the ball out deep in their territory. Kent Deckerhoff throws in high in front of Godby's goal allowing Nicolai Modrow to shoot which the Godby keeper stops. After the goal kick, Nicolai Modrow tries a shot that hits the crossbar and bounces out. Alex Schroepfer then grabs the ball and attempts a shot that Godby's keeper stops.

Further play allows Chris Kessler to take a shot that misses to the left in the 42<sup>nd</sup> minute. Godby's keeper then kicks a goal kick that Nicolai Modrow picks off and shoots at GOAL in the 43<sup>rd</sup> minute!

Chiles 3 – Godby 0.

After Godby's kick off, another Chiles drive produces a corner kick which Kent Deckerhoff sends high in front of Godby's goal allowing Nathan Eppinger to take a shot that misses left in the 45<sup>th</sup> minute. Godby then has a drive resulting in shot that misses Chiles' goal wide left in the 48<sup>th</sup> minute.

In another Chiles drive, Chris Kessler passes to Kent Deckerhoff who sends a big cross up in front of Godby's goal allowing Daniel Campbell to shoot but miss over goal top in the 53<sup>rd</sup> minute. While attempting to snatch a Godby clear, the ball is out on Chiles just inside midfield on Godby's side. Godby throws in, but Chris Kessler steals that ball and feeds it to Kent Deckerhoff who shoots a GOAL in the 53<sup>rd</sup> minute!

Chiles 4 – Godby 0.

Chiles' shooting spree continues when Nicolai Modrow passes to Chris Kessler who passes to Jake Parker who takes a shot that is stopped by Godby's keeper in the 55<sup>th</sup> minute. Godby's keeper clears, and Godby drives but loses the ball out Chiles' endline. Taylor Kostrewa sends the goal kick to midfield where Kent Deckerhoff picks it up and works with Nicolai Modrow, Cole Hoffman, and Jake Parker to set up a shot that Kent fires off in the 59<sup>th</sup> minute but misses the Godby goal just left.

On the ensuing goal kick, Godby starts a drive down the far sideline, but Cole Hoffman picks the ball off near midfield and switches to Kent Deckerhoff. Kent jukes out a Godby defender, drives down the near sideline and crosses to Daniel Campbell at the top of the box, but Daniel cannot get a shot. Derek Reed comes in for Cole Hoffman. Colby Sowerby comes in for Daniel Campbell. Play resumes on a Chiles throw-in near midfield where Derek Reed passes to Chris Kessler who sends the ball back to Derek who shoots in the 61<sup>st</sup> minute that misses high over the goal top. Further play produces a Kent Deckerhoff low crossing corner kick to Colby Sowerby who shoots but misses wide right in 62<sup>nd</sup> minute. After a Godby goal kick, Derek Reed steals the ball at midfield and passes to Kent Deckerhoff who dribbles through Godby plays to take a shot in the 63<sup>rd</sup> minute that the Godby defenders block.

Play resumes with drop ball kick that Godby's keeper clears to midfield where Nicolai Modrow makes a stop and feeds to Kent Deckerhoff who switches to Derek Reed who, in turn, crosses Colby Sowerby who sends in a shot that Godby's keeper stops in the 64<sup>th</sup> minute. Another Chiles drive produces a Chris Kessler shot that deflects off the left goal upright and misses left in the 65<sup>th</sup> minute. The Timberwolves continue this oppressive shooting when Colby Sowerby makes a fast run up the near sideline and crosses to Nicolai Modrow who shoots but misses wide left in the 66<sup>th</sup> minute.

Chiles' relentless shooting finally produces another goal when Kent Deckerhoff throws in to Nicolai Modrow. Nicolai feeds back to Samuel Weeks who switches to Derek Reed. Derek and Colby Sowerby then advance passing back and forth until Derek sends back to Alex Schroeffer who crosses to Nicolai Modrow to shoot a GOAL from inside the box in the 66<sup>th</sup> minute!

Chiles 5 – Godby 0.

Luke Olsen comes in for Nicolai Modrow. Daniel Campbell substitutes in. Evan Cameron subs in for Chris Kessler. When play resumes, Colby Sowerby picks off a Godby goal kick and takes a shot that misses right in the 68<sup>th</sup> minute. After Godby clears, further play results in a Godby penalty. Alex Schroeffer takes the free kick from 35 yards which the Godby keeper deflects up into the crossbar where the ball bounces in for a Chiles GOAL in the 72<sup>nd</sup> minute!

Chiles 6 – Godby 0.

The remaining time produces no further goals, but plenty of Chiles shooting. On a corner by Colby Sowerby, Daniel Campbell takes a shot that the Godby defenders deflect back allowing Derek Reed to run up from midfield and launch a power kick that deflects off the top of the crossbar and misses in the 75<sup>th</sup> minute. On a Godby throw-in, Nathan Eppinger steals the ball and passes to Daniel Campbell who crosses to Derek Reed who shoots in the 78<sup>th</sup> minute but misses wide left.

During the second period stoppage, Daniel Campbell throws in to Colby Sowerby who passes to Evan Cameron who shoots but Godby's keeper stops. Evan also picks off a Godby goal kick and passes to Luke Olsen who shoots but misses over the top of the goal.

The Timberwolves end the match happy with their extensive shooting and impressive win.
