

**Chiles v. Rickards**

The Timberwolves beat the Rickards Raiders 7 – 0 on a cool Wednesday evening at Rickard's field. The setting sun silhouetted the 6 p.m. kickoff.

The Chiles starting lineup was as follows:

Jake Parker and Evan Cameron represented Chiles at the captains' meeting.

Chiles kicked off and dominated field control in the first period. Rickards rarely drove past midfield, and when they did Justin Dillenschneider usually cleared back to the Rickards' side. A Kent Deckerhoff assist allows Nicolai Modrow to kick in an easy opening GOAL at the 1 minute mark in the first period. The second goal occurred when Chiles drove down through the center of Rickards' defenders and Chris Kessling shot a GOAL at the 4<sup>th</sup> minute.

After a midfield battle for ball control, Jake Parker drove up the far sideline, fed to Nicolai Modrow who dribbled around in the Rickards' corner. Rickards clears the ball out to Samuel Weeks who shoots in the 6<sup>th</sup> minute, but Rickards' keeper stops. Bryan McBride and Luke Olsen come in for Chiles and Kent Deckerhoff and Chris Kessling go out. Jake Parker then breaks on another drive that allows Cole Hoffman to shoot a GOAL at the 10 minute mark.

After the Rickards kickoff, a midfield battle occurs. Chiles wins control and attempts to feed to Luke Olsen down the sideline, but an offside is called. Jake Autrey comes in for Chiles. In the 16<sup>th</sup> minute, Rickards shoots from near midfield, but misses the goal to the right. Another Chiles drive allows a Conner Munro shot that misses the goal to the left in the 18<sup>th</sup> minute.

Ali Farsi comes in for Chiles. A Rickards foul just outside the box allows Ali to attempt a free kick at the goal which Rickards' keeper stops. Daniel Campbell and Joey Antworth come in for Chiles. On a corner kick by Matt Salib, a partial clear by Rickards

defenders allows Conner Munro to shoot in the 30<sup>th</sup> minute, but the ball sails over the top of the goal.

Rickards drives to Chiles' side, but Chiles clears. On a subsequent Chiles drive, Luke Olsen attempts a fastbreak but is held by Rickards defenders. A wide pass by Bryant McBride then allows Matt Salib to shoot a GOAL in the 34<sup>th</sup> minute. Joey Antworth also shoots a GOAL in the 35<sup>th</sup> minute. Play continues back and forth until halftime.

HALFTIME: Chiles 5 – Rickards 0.

Colby Sowerby, Joey Antworth, Luke Olsen, Jake Autrey, Bryant McBride, Daniel Campbell, Debo Farrell, Conner Munro, Matt Salib, and Taylor Kostrewa begin play for Chiles in the second period. After play resumes, a pass to the far side allows Matt Salib to attempt a shot that Rickards' keeper stops in the 47<sup>rd</sup> minute.

Matt Salib shoots again in the 55<sup>th</sup> minute, and Conner Munro takes two shots in the 57<sup>th</sup> minute, all of which are stopped by Rickards' keeper. A Rickards' clear to midfield allows Jake Autrey to attempt a shot from just inside midfield that sails out over the top of the goal at the 58 minute mark. Colby Sowerby makes cross that allows Matt Salib to shoot a GOAL at the 59 minute mark.

Cole Hoffman, Derek Reed, Chris Kessler, and Jake Parker come back in for Chiles. Luke Olsen gets a fastbreak starting a midfield, drives for Rickards' goal, and shoots but Rickards' keeper stops. After further play, Samuel Weeks and Alex Schroepfer sub in for Conner Munro and Luke Olsen. The ball bounces back and forth with no team in clear control. The ball is out several times. Chiles regains control and drives back to Rickards' side, but cannot get a shot. After switching the field, Derek Reed runs at the goal for a shot but is taken down by Rickards' keeper on a slide tackle.

Other Chiles drives at goal produce no clear shots or result in offsides. The ball is kept mostly on Rickards' side and Rickards takes no shots at Chiles' goal during this time. The Chiles defense holds strong. Luke Olsen comes in and Chris Kessler goes out. A foul in Rickards' goal box allows Jake Parker to take a penalty kick that results in the final GOAL in the 79<sup>th</sup> minute.

FINAL: Chiles 7 – Rickards 0

The loyal Timberwolves fans again make a strong showing to support the team.
